## 5th Grade Supply List 2018-2019

- 2 pkgs. Ticonderoga 24 count #2 pencils
- 1pkg. Of blue or black pens (ballpoint preferred)
- 1pkg. Of Multi-colored pens or Paper mate Flair Pens, Assorted colors(for interactive notebooks)
- Staedtler White Hi-Polymer Erasers, multi pack
- 1 Pack of highlighter markers (assorted colors)
- 24 count of Crayola crayons
- 12 count of Crayola colored pencils
- 1 pkg Crayola markers for art and art t-shirt
- 1 ½ " heavy duty binder of any color with a clear plastic front( for their schedule)
- 1 set of 8 plastic dividers with pockets (Avery) #16177 or Any other brand)
- 1 zippered pencil pouch
- 1 scissor (please make them age 8 and up)
- 2 bottles of Elmer's white glue
- 100 count pkg. **WIDE-RULED**, loose-leaf paper
- 2---100 count packages of 3X5 index cards--lined, white
- 2--500 count pkgs. Copy paper
- 1--500 count pkg. Of pastel, assorted colored copy paper (not cardstock)
- 2 plastic folders with prongs for music and Spanish
